Ubud Tour

Ubud is the cultural and arts centre of Bali. Our driver will take you to the most iconic sites in and around Ubud:

Ubud Palace

Also known as Puri Saren Agung, is a cultural hub where visitors can experience Balinese traditional dance performances, art exhibitions, and royal events. The palace's intricate carvings and beautiful architecture offer a glimpse into the island's rich history and culture.

Ubud Monkey Forest Sanctuary

Almost 1,000 monkeys live within the sanctuary. This is a 12-hectare (30 acre) jungle area surrounding an old 14th century Hindu temple and is located in the heart of Ubud.

Barong Dance

A classic Balinese dance telling the story of good triumphing over evil. The Barong is a large lion type creature played by two men and Rangda is the epitome of evil with long fingernails and droopy breasts.

Celuk Village

Famous for its incredible handcrafted artisans who specialise in Silver and Gold ornaments. Great place for shopping.

Batuan Temple

Noted for its artwork and style of painting which originated in the village and has since emerged into a major Balinese artistic style, known as Batuan painting.

Mas Village

One of the villages in Bali identified as an artistic centre focusing on the art of wood carving.

Tegenungan Waterfall

Famous waterfall where you can take a short hike through the jungle to a hidden, magical waterfall and take a cool swim if you wish. A great photo opportunity!

Goa Gajah

'Elephant Cave' is an archaeological site of significant historical value that makes it a special place to visit.

This tour will take approximately 8 to 10 hours, so ideal start time is after an early breakfast. Please note that entrance fees, lunch, dinner, etc are not included in our rates.







Uluwatu Tour

Uluwatu is on the south-western tip of the Bukit Peninsula of Bali. It is home to the Pura Luhur Uluwatu Temple. The area has great beaches and Jimbaran has some of the best seafood beachfront restaurants in Bali.







Nusa Dua

Is the best place to do water sports such as Banana Boat, Snorkelling, Diving, Sea Walker, Flying Fish, Jet Ski, Parasailing, and you can also visit the Turtle Island by Glass Bottom Boat.

Garuda Wisnu Kencana (GWK)

Is a cultural park covering anapproximately 60 hectares located in Ungasan, Badung Regency. It is devoted to the Hindu God Vishnu, and his mount, Garuda the mythical bird who became his companion.

Padang – Padang Beach

Is famous for surf sport, featuring a hundred meter long stretch of stunning sand that is accessible down a flight of stairs through a unique hollow rock entrance.

Uluwatu Temple

Is built at the edge (ulu) of a 70 metre high cliff of rock (watu) facing stunning blue sea. The temple is regarded as one of the sad kahyangan and is dedicated to Sang Hyang Widhi Wasa in his manifestation as Rudra. Famous Fire Kecak Dance starts every evening at 6.00 PM near the temple.

Jimbaran Bay

Is a great place for sunset drinks and has some of the best seafood beachfront restaurants in Bali.

This tour will take approximately 8 to 10 hours, so ideal start time is after an early breakfast. Please note that entrance fees, lunch, dinner, etc is not included in our rates.



Kintamani is on the western edge of the larger caldera wall of the Mount Batur Bali.

Barong Dance

Is the classic Balinese dancing telling the story of good triumphing over evil. The Barong is a large lion type creature played by two men and Rangda is the epitome of evil with long fingernails and droopy breasts.

Celuk Village

Famous for its incredible handcrafted artisans who specialise in Silver and Gold ornaments. Great place for shopping.

Batuan Village

Is noted for its artwork and style of painting which originated in the village and has since emerged into a major Balinese artistic style, known as a Batuan Village.

Mas Village

One of villages in Bali identified as an artistic centre focusing on the art of wood carving.

Tampak Siring

This temple compound consists of a bathing structure, famous for its holy spring water called Tirta Empul where Balinese Hindus go to for ritual purification.

See how Balinese coffee is made in the traditional way and visit various tropical plantations such as Robusta coffee, pineapple, cacao, jackfruit, and durian tree.

Kintamani

Is a village on the western edge of the larger caldera wall of Mount Batur from the road you can see the famous volcano.

Tegalalang Rice Terrace

Is famous for the beautiful rice terraces. The verdant terraced rice field scenery is a great photo opportunity.

This tour will take approximately 8 to 10 hours, so ideal start time is after an early breakfast. Please note that entrance fees, lunch, dinner, etc is not included in our rates.






Bedugul Tour ♥

This area with lakes and mountains is located in the center of the island near Lake Bratan and includes the villages of Bedugul itself, Candikuning, Pancasari, Pacung and Wanagiri.







Mengwi

Is a village famous for the Taman Ayun Temple with its multi-storied roof and Balinese architecture, surrounded by a big pond where the fish seem to drift on the water.

Bali Coffee Tropical Plantations

See how Balinese coffee in made in the traditional way and visit various tropical plantations such as Robusta coffee, pineapple, cacao, jackfruit, and durian tree.

Bedugul

Is famous for its Hindu temple - Ulun Danu Temple - which is located on the banks of Beratan lake with a beautiful panorama view of the lake and the mountain as a backdrop.

Pacung

Beautiful rice terrace with the backdrop of Pacung valley.

Alas Kedaton

A beautiful monkey forest located in the western part of Bali with a Hindu Temple at its heart.

Tanah Lot

An iconic Balinese Temple built on the rock overlooking the sea and famous for its spectacular sunsets.

This tour will take approximately 8 to 10 hours, so ideal start time is after an early breakfast. Please note that entrance fees, lunch, dinner, etc is not included in our rates.

Jatiluwih Tour

Jatiluwih is situated 700 meters above sea level and offers a cool breeze to view beautiful panoramas of terraced rice fields and quaint Balinese villages.

Bali Butterfly Park

Is a conservation facility with various species from all over the Indonesia archipelago. An interesting experience is to see closely the many stages of the metamorphoses of different species, from egg, larvae and pupae, to cocoon and large life-size butterflies.

Batukaru Temple

Referred to by locals as Pura Luhur Batukaru. This is one of the nine directional temples on the island, called Khayangan Jagat, which protects the island and its inhabitants from evil spirits. Batukaru Temple is a very sacred place to the Balinese, and one of the reasons for this, is the 7-tiered meru that can be found within the temple.

Jatiluwih Rice Terrace

Is one of the most famous tourist destination in Bali with views of rice fields stretching from the foot of the mountain to the beach and has been designated as a UNESCO world heritage site because it is able to preserve local cultural heritage in the form of water. The traditionally managed irrigation system is called Subak.

Tanah Lot.

An iconic Balinese Temple built on the rock overlooking the sea and famous for its spectacular sunsets.

This tour will take approximately 8 to 10 hours, so ideal start time is after an early breakfast. Please note that entrance fees, lunch, dinner, etc is not included in our rates.

Besakih Temple

Is often referred to as Bali's 'mother temple' – a grand complex of at least 86 clan temples and shrines on the south-western slopes of Mount Agung. At least 70 celebrations take place at Besakih every year, each shrine has its own anniversary. Besakih is considered to be the biggest and holiest of Bali's temples. Its high location offers spectacular countryside views with rice paddies, hills, mountains, and streams.

Barong Dance

Is the classic Balinese dancing telling the story of good triumphing over evil. The Barong is a large lion type creature played by two men and Rangda is the epitome of evil with long fingernails and droopy breasts.

Celuk Village

Famous for its incredible handcrafted artisans who specialise in Silver and Gold ornaments. Great place for shopping.

Batuan Village

Is noted for its artwork and style of painting which originated in the village and has since emerged into a major Balinese artistic style, known as a Batuan Village.

Mas Village

The Kerta Gosa Pavilion

Built in the 18th century, is a fine example of Balinese architecture located in Klungkung.

Bukit Jambul

Is renowned as an outstanding natural tourist destination due to the harmonious combination of hilly land, rice fields, valleys and the beautiful sea panorama in a distance.

This tour will take approximately 8 to 10 hours, so ideal start time is after an early breakfast. Please note that entrance fees, lunch, dinner, etc is not included in our rates.

Git-git Waterfall

Is known for its stunning beauty and serene atmosphere,

It is a breath taking natural attraction located in the Buleleng Regency of Bali. Situated in the village of Gitgit, the waterfall is surrounded by lush greenery and offers a refreshing respite from the heat of the island.

Mengwi

Is a village famous for Taman Ayun Temple with its multi-storied roof and Balinese Architecture, surrounded by a big pond where the fish seem to drift on the water.

Bali Zoo

A wonderful wildlife conservation. The Zoo takes visitors on a jungle tour, where you can see the animals close up, and admire the tropical flora and beautiful setting. Visitors can walk along the paths with lush tropical plantations and soft sound of fountains drops from the surrounding ponds. Visitors can also ride an Elephant around the park.

Monkey Forest

Covers approximately a tenth of a square kilometre (approximately 10 hectares or 27 acres) and contain at least 115 different species of trees. The park is heavily forested and hilly. A deep ravine runs through the park grounds, at the bottom of which flows a rocky stream. Trails allow visitor access to many parts of the park, including the ravine and stream.

Bali Bird Park

Has an area of 20.000 square metres (4.9 acres). The Bird Park houses more than 5000 birds representing more than 200 species in an enclosed aviary.

This tour will take approximately 8 to 10 hours, so ideal start time is after an early breakfast. Please note that entrance fees, lunch, dinner, etc is not included in our rates.
